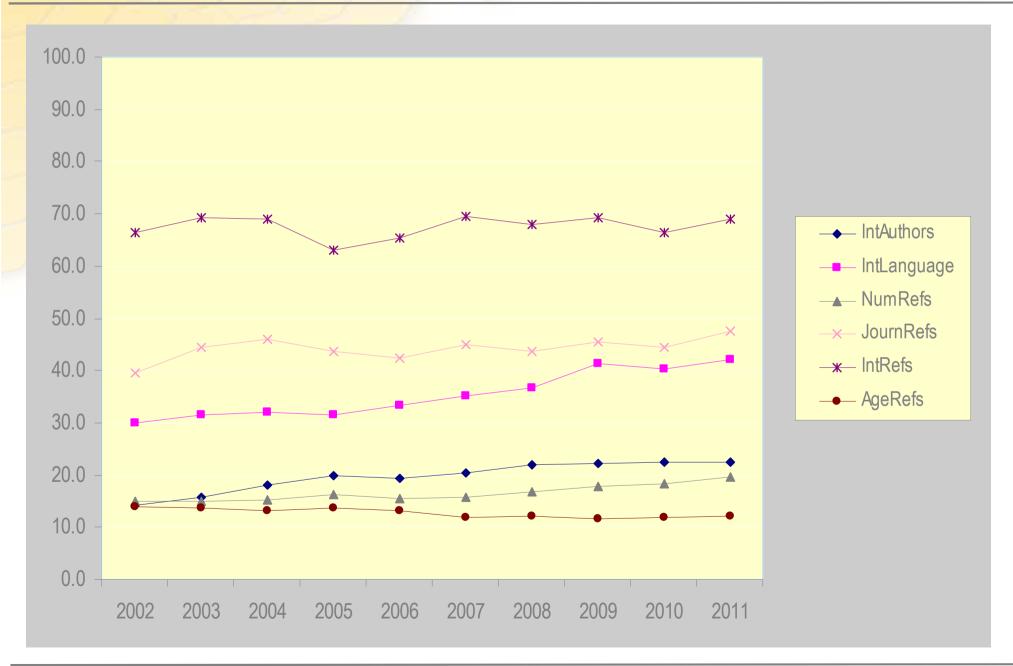






JBR: Quality indicators - Serbian WoS journals









JBR: Quality indicators - All Serbian journals
